PRINCIPAL'S UPDATE – 17TH APRIL 2025

The building is prepped and ready for its roof refurbishment and we have lots of planned events we wish to share for your diaries.

Statutory Assessment Dates (a reminder of the information previously published in the 10th January update):

This year's statutory assessment dates are shown below. It is crucial that children in these year groups attend school leading up to, and particularly during, the assessment period so they do not miss key review preparations and the statutory tests.

KS2 SATs

Year 6 pupils will be taking their Key Stage 2 SATs (Statutory Assessment Tests) from Monday 12th May to Thursday 15th May 2025. The SATs are nothing to worry about and are the same as other tests that our children have taken during their time at Richmond Hill, with the main difference being that they are marked externally and not by school staff. It is important our children just try their best and show the confidence and resilience they have developed over these years.

Year 1 Phonics Screening Check

The Phonics Screening Check for all Year 1 children and Y2 re-sits will take place during w/c 9th June 2025. A Parents' Meeting (virtually via Microsoft Teams) to give parents information about the Phonics Screening Check has been arranged for 3.45pm on Monday 28th April - link to follow.

Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check

The MTC tests for our Year 4 pupils will take place during w/c 2rd June and w/c 9th June.

KS1 Assessments:

Pupils in Year 2 will start their assessments from 7th May-9th May and will continue during w/c 19th May (following the Y6 SATs).
